In memory of Mary Staal

Mary Staal, the wife of the late Gerardus Staal passed away on April 15 of this year after a brief illness. Gerardus was the orchid hybridizer known to many of us at the Peninsula Orchid Society (and several others) for years, and Mary was always there with her love and support; as a matter of fact I cannot think of a closer relationship. Mary was a remarkable lady to those who knew and cared for her, and she was very dear to me, someone I loved very much. After Gerardus passed in February of 2014 I would continue to visit her, trying to see her every month or two. We would go out for meals or just stay home chatting. I knew a bit about her from her amazing stories, but I recently learned more that I want to share.

Mary was born in Oosterhout in the Netherlands on October 24, 1929. She married Gerardus in 1957, and they were married for 57 years. As I mentioned, the two shared

so much love and support for each other, and for their close family, that is was inspiring. Unknown to most, Mary was a policewoman for five years in Arhem City in the Netherlands, and was one of the first woman officers in that city.
