### GROWING UNDER LIGHTS

Speaker: Kelly McCracken

Kelly McCracken, owner of High Desert Orchids, started as an avid hobbyist, and like many of you, couldn't stop buying plants. Quickly one greenhouse became two, and now she grows plants in a unique 3,000 sq ft high-bay industrial warehouse space, all under artificial lights. Kelly specializes in miniature plants, with a particular affection for miniature Cattleyas , Angraecoids, Jewel Orchids, and Dendrobiums.

Kelly has authored articles for Orchids magazine. Her approach to growing under lights has resulted from in-depth research into what types of lights work best for orchids, why your light meter may not give you the information you need, why some currently popular lights are likely to give you disappointing results and why it is important to understand the shape of your light.

I heard this presentation given to Santa Clara Valley OS. I don't grow under lights nor do I plan to, but I still learned a lot of valuable information that will improve my orchid culture.

#### THE GENERAL IDEA

Peninsula Orchid Society will hold an online auction in January. Our goal is to provide a way for members with orchids to sell to connect with people who would like to have new orchids. Bidders will not have a chance to inspect the plants in person prior to bidding. Therefore photos and descriptions will be needed from sellers and donors.

The auction committee will begin posting the orchid entries on the auction site beginning January 8. Bidders will be able to preview during that time. This gives you a great chance to research the plants your are interested in prior to bidding.

Bidding will open on January 21 at 5:00 PM. Bidders will receive a text or email (or no notification, as desired) when they have been outbid. They then have the option to increase their bid. The auction will end at 3:00 PM on Saturday, January 29. If a new high bid is placed on an item in the last five minutes of the auction, the bidding time will remain open another five minutes on that item. This will continue until there has been no bidding on that item for five minutes at which time the bidding will close.

Entries may continue to be added during the auction if the limit of 250 plants has not been reached before the start of the auction.

We want to set this up for minimal contact. We will have one day (Sunday, January 30) for plant intake (morning) and pickup (afternoon). You can have a friend deliver or pick up your plants for you - you must email Chaunie at chaunie@cluemail.com to arrange this.

Sellers and volunteers will be required to wear masks (properly) at all times at the SMGC and social distance as reasonable on January 30. Volunteers will pack the sold orchids into boxes for pickup. Buyers must wear a mask (properly) while in the area of where the volunteers are.

There are a lot of rules and instructions following. (You thought you had seen the worst of it already?) Please read the section(s) appropriate for your role. Sellers and donors must be current POS members. Entries should be emailed to chaunie@cluemail.com. Some non-orchid plants are being allowed in this auction.

# SELLER AND DONOR INSTRUCTIONS

**Must be a current POS member** (join or renew at http://penorchidsoc.org/membership.html)

#### **Plant entry information**

Plant entries will open on January 7, 2022. Entries should be emailed to chaunie@cluemail.com.

#### Each entry must have

- (1) your auction number, three initials plus a two digit number
- (2) plant or item name
- (3) description (including something about the size of the plant)
- (4) starting bid price
- (5) photo of the actual plant or item up to five photos per item, max. 4MB/photo

# A spread sheet with this information and the auction number included in your photo file name would be much appreciated.

This time you may offer up to five plants that are not orchids. However, they must be legal - no cuttings or starts from patented plants. Do you have other related items to sell? (Bark, pots, hangers, books, posters, etc.) You may enter those also.

### How many can you sell or donate?

Maximum number of items per seller or donor is 40 until January 17. If there are still open slots they may be filled. You may send your extra entries, if any, at the time you send your 40 entries. If so please indicate their order so we are sure to get your first 40 into the auction for sure.

- Entries can be added until end of day January 26 if slots are still available.
- Entries are on a first come first served basis.

### How the plants get transferred

- Sellers and donors must deliver their plants to the SMGC, 605 Parkside Way, San Mateo, CA between 9:30 AM and 11:30 AM on Sunday, January 30, 2022. You must wear a mask while outside your vehicle.
- Each plant must be clearly marked with the auction ID number.
- Any plants deemed unsuitable due to pest infestation, bacterial infection seen on leaves (unless clearly visible on auction photo), lack of establishment or general poor condition will be returned to sellers or donors immediately. Sellers and donors must remain on site until their plants have been checked in.
- Bidders are welcome to inspect and virus test any plants they purchase and return them immediately. If your plant is returned we will contact you to arrange disposition of the plant.

#### **Money**

- Sellers will receive 75% of the selling price of the plant. Peninsula Orchid Society will retain 25% of the selling price. POS will pay the auction fees to the auction site from this money.
- Donors will receive a donation form for their taxes.
- POS will collect and pay the sales tax.
- Your check will be mailed to you by February 18, 2022.

# BIDDER INFORMATION

Anyone may bid on plants, but you do need to live close enough to pick up your plants at the San Mateo Garden Center, 605 Parkside Way, San Mateo, CA on Sunday, January 30 between 12:15 PM and 2:30 PM. We will NOT ship any plants or other items.

#### How does the auction work?

Register online at https://www.charityauctionstoday.com/auctions/peninsula-os-january-2022-auction-29361. Your credit card information will be required to bid, but you can register and see the offerings without entering your credit card information. Your card information is not held by POS or Charity Auctions Online but by Stripe, the credit card processing company.

You will be able to preview auction items beginning January 9. Entries may continue to be added during the auction if the limit of 250 plants has not been reached before the start of the auction so check back.

When viewing the entries there are two things you need to know:

- 1. Each orchid is entered either in the species or hybrid category. If you click on the word species or hybrid in the path at the top of the window, then you will see only orchids entered in that category. The previous and next buttons will keep you in that category. If you click Home you will go back to seeing all of the entries. We will also have related orchid items and a few non-orchid plants available for sale.
- 2. Most entries contain multiple photos. Click on the arrows at the side of the photo to see another photo of that plant.

You will have the option to receive text messages or an email when you have been outbid. You may also check the bidding progress online.

The auction will close at 3:00 PM on Saturday, January 29.

At the close of the auction your credit card will automatically be billed for the plants you have won. You will receive an invoice, which will include the list of plants you are purchasing, via email.

#### How do you get your orchids?

You must be able to pick up your plants at the San Mateo Garden Center, 605 Parkside Way, San Mateo, Ca. between 12:15 PM and 2:30 PM on Sunday, January 30, 2022.

You can have a friend pick up your plants for you - you must email Chaunie at <a href="mailto:chaunie@cluemail.com">chaunie@cluemail.com</a> to arrange this.

### We will NOT SHIP ANY PLANTS OR ITEMS.

You may get out of your car to get your plants while wearing a mask or you may ask us to deliver your plants to your car. You can text Chaunie from your car. Mobile # information will be on your invoice.

You may drive a short distance away to inspect your plants and check your plants against your invoice. You are welcome to virus test your plants during your inspection. You will have 20 minutes to return should you find any issues. We will do our darnedest to make sure there aren't any.


