Orchid Talk:

Gerry Walsh will be speaking to us about growing native Australian orchid species, particularly Sarcochilus and Dendrobium species.

"I've been growing Australian Native Orchid species since 1975. The most absorbing for me has always been *Dendrobium speciosum* in all its nine varieties. The variety I've concentrated on mostly has always been variety grandiflorum. Grandiflorum is known for very large, deep yellow blooms on racemes up to 2.5 feet long. They frequently have over a hundred blooms on board. I've travelled thousands of miles over my orchiding life to see them flowering in the wild mountains near the Tropic of Capricorn, in central Queensland. I suggest that if you Americans want to grow them to their very best, then you should be studying how they grow in the wilds of the Australian bush. That is what you're going to see in my talk coming to you soon. Looking forward to meeting you all."
